Sisters For Sisters (SFS) is producing another magical Episode on **Sunday 1st of June 7pm @ The Toff** for the Punarnava Trust, a charitable Trust, wholly focused on improving the health, education, and welfare of the South Indian village populations.

The organisation SFS is assisting is based in Tamil Nadu, India, where Carla Beasley, a member of the SFS collective spent time volunteering earlier this year.

The vision is to build a children's home/orphanage for 30 children in the local and surrounding area.

The Children's home will provide accommodation as well as be a learning centre, where government and state level education requirements are met, along with the teachings of traditional Ayurveda, yoga and meditation, organic gardening and cooking. It will be completely run by volunteers.

The long term vision is to create more sustainable outcomes for the local villages through this education, accommodation and support. Currently there is very little access to water, food and resources available, and challenging social issues of alcoholism, violence and poverty.
